How to receive new life in Christ:

Every individual needs to make a personal decision to follow Jesus Christ. We become Christians by making a conscious choice to surrender our lives to God. This decision is made by:

1. **Believing** that Jesus Christ died for our sins;
2. **Accepting** his forgiveness for and turning away from our sin;
3. **Receiving** Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord, by faith; and
4. **Declaring** our faith in a public way.

Is it your desire to become a Christian? Pray a prayer like this: "Oh God, I acknowledge that I have sinned against You. I am sorry for my sins, and I am willing to turn away from them. I now receive Jesus Christ as my Savior, and accept Him as Lord of my life. From this moment on, I will live for Him. In Jesus' name, Amen."

If you have prayed this prayer to receive Jesus Christ as your Lord and Savior, then you are now a child of God (John 1:12).

It is important that when you receive Christ's love and forgiveness you tell someone about it as soon as possible. Tell a pastor and one or two close friends; it will help seal this act of faith in your mind and heart.

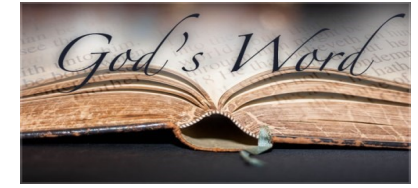
